- A single worker policy is in operation in the Pro Shop and Driving Range.
- Number of customers in the Pro Shop at any one time is restricted.
- Where possible please make payments by contactless card.

- Enter the Clubhouse via the changing rooms.
- All internal doors to remain propped open.
- Wash your hands when entering the Clubhouse.

- Practice social distancing (6ft 6in).
- No hand shaking before or after your round.
- Flags must be left in the hole at all times.
- Bunker rakes removed; sand to be smoothed with a club.
- One person to score per playing group.
- One person to enter scores on the PSI.
- Use screen wipes at the side of the PSI before and after use.
- Place wipes in the bins.
- Put the scorecards in the competition boxes.
- No more than two people in the Locker Room at any one time.
